On-Wall Bottle Filler

Product Description

The Aquatru Pro Series On-Wall Bottle filler shall be wall-mounted, filtered, and refrigerated. Bottle Filler shall be built with a Stainless-Steel exterior, with a cooling system using R290 refrigerant, and able to produce 9.5 GPH of chilled water under ASHRAE 18 standard testing. The filter shall reduce Chlorine, PFAS/PFOS Cyst, taste and odor, Lead, and Particulate Class 1. Bottle Filler shall have a digital bottle count display indicating the number of 16 oz plastic bottles saved. Bottle count shall be measured by the metered flow meter. Bottle Filler shall have a visual filter display indicating filter status and the need for replacement. Unit shall be rated for indoor installation or outdoor in covered applications.

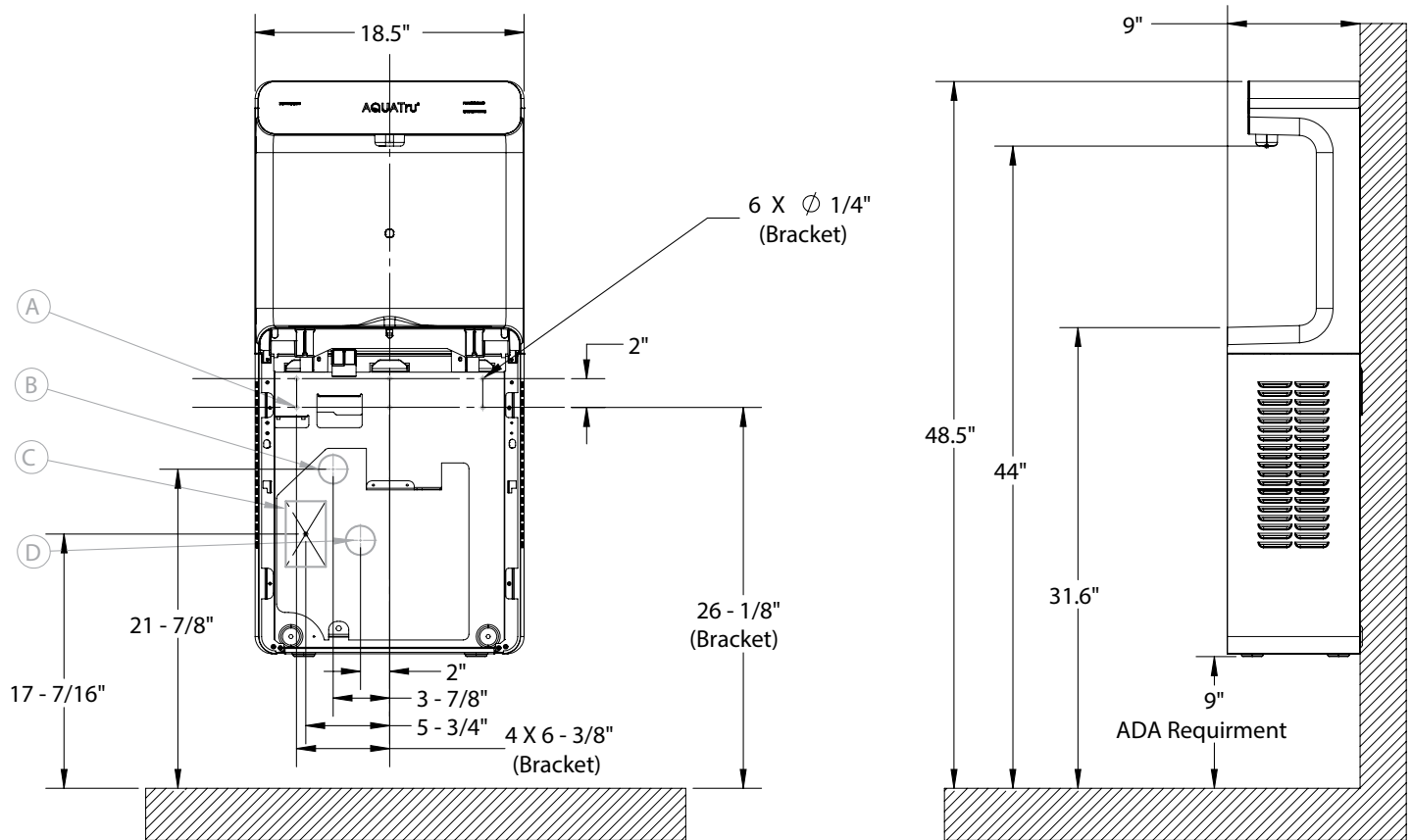

- B. RECOMMENDED DRAIN LINE PLACEMENT
- C. RECOMMENDED ELECTRICAL SOCKET PLACEMENT
- D. RECOMMENDED WATER SUPPLY PLACEMENT

NOTE: TO INSTALL DEVICE ACCORDING TO ADA REQUIRMENTS DO THE FOLLOWING:

1. LOCATE THE CENTER LINE OF THE INTENDED INSTALLATION LOCATION
2. MEASURE UP 26 - 1/8" FROM THE FLOOR AND SCRIBE A LINE. THIS LINE MARKS THE HEIGHT OF THE LOWER BOLT HOLES FOR THE HANGER BRACKET
